Fun in the sun



With only two events left in the 2009 V8 Supercar season the Bundy Red Racing Team is determined to finish the year on a high, starting with two solid race results at this weekend's Bigpond 300 in Perth Western Australia.

It has been a while since Reynolds has raced at Perth's permanent motorsport venue and he is yet to drive a V8 Supercar around the short 2.4km circuit.

He last visited the circuit in 2005 and is looking forward

to heading west to take on the challenge in the #24 Bundy Red Commodore.

"I am looking forward to it, the Perth circuit is only a short track so hopefully that means it is going to be easier for me to learn and adjust to," Reynolds said.

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"I haven't been to the circuit since 2005 which was just after it had been re-surfaced and it had quite a lot of grip, but I hear it has deteriorated since then so I am expecting it to be quite different," he said.

Reynolds has displayed consistent pace over the last few events and this weekend is going to be about building on that speed and putting together the right race package.

"I hope to be able to qualify a little bit better," Reynolds said.

"My goal for this event is to be able to consistently race in the top ten and Jason (Bush, car #24 Engineer) and I will be working extremely hard to try and achieve that," he said.

The soft tyre also returns for

the 13th event of the year and Reynolds has been able to extract the speed he needs by utilising the softer compound tyre.

"I actually like the soft tyre, it suits my driving style so I am pretty pleased it is back in play this weekend," Reynolds said.

"I have a lot more confidence on the soft tyre as opposed to the harder compound tyre, it just feels more natural for me," he said.

"But in saying that the downside is that the tyre falls away quite

quickly. The heat and the surface are going to play a big part in that," he said.

The Bigpond 300 starts this Friday 20th November with practice in the afternoon. Qualifying and Race 23 (100km) are on Saturday with a further qualifying session and Race 24 (200km) on Sunday.
